Hares of **Bumcrack** and **Tyre Fruck** as well as early birds **Druid**, and **Colonel**Sanders.



# **History Corner Storming the Bastille**



The **Storming of the Bastille** occurred in Paris, France, on the morning of 14 July 1789. The medieval fortress and prison in Paris known as the Bastille represented royal authority in the center of Paris. The prison contained just seven inmates at the time of its storming but was a symbol of the abuses of the monarchy: its fall was the flashpoint of the French Revolution.

The origins of the storming was started when King Louis XVI convened the Estate General - The  ${f 1}^{\rm st}$  **Estate** represented the Catholic Clergy of 10,000 who paid No taxes but owned 10% of French land


The  $2^{nd}$  Estate were 400,000 nobles who also paid no taxes , The  $3^{rd}$  Estate represented 25million common people who did pay taxes

Together these Estates formed the **National Assembly**. The dismissal of the Finance minister, James Necker by Louis ( who championed limited consitutional monarchy) inflamed Parisions which led to the stroming of the Bastille and led to a 10 year of bloody rebellion finishing in 1805 whereafter Napoleon tooj the reinfs until 1814

Within 25 years of the initial Bastille, July 14, 1789, the **House of Bourbon** had resumed its gilded thrown with Louis XVIII in 1814

# Harper Lee and "To Kill a Mockingbird" – published July 1960- 55 years young



After nearly 55 years since publishing "To kill a Mockingbird" in July 1960, Lee Harper is set to launch her second book at the age of 89!. Th highly anticipated sequel is to be called "Go set a Watchmen" and is set in the 1950's. Some of the characters are from her 1st novel 20 years on.

Lee was born in Monroeville, Alabama in 1926 and her father was a distinguished lawyer, member of the State Legislature as well as partly owning a newspaper business.

Controversy erupted soon after Harper Collins Publishers announced the rights to publish a newly discovered unpublished 60 year novel. – sounds like good promotion for the new novel!

Harper Lee remains an enigma as one of the most famous authors for a single novel.
